




CNL-MFS-BL/SC/SL NIGHT HAWK METAL FRAME STRIKE**■ STRIKE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Close the door and using the lock case as a guide, mark the position to install the strike on the metal jamb.




2. Align the strike mounting plate centrally within the marked horizontal lines, and position the tongue on the strike mounting plate flush with the door jamb.

Mark and secure with four
10G x 1/2" metal screws.



3. Place strike onto strike mounting plate and slide sideways into position.

Secure with two
M5 x 26mm Screw Pins.



4. The installation of the Night Hawk metal frame strike is now complete.

Special Notes:

INWARD OPENING INSTALLATION: Refer to lock installation instructions and template.

OUTWARD OPENING INSTALLATION: Outward opening strike is sold separately, product code CNL-OSSC.

SECURITY: For maximum security, the gap between the lock case and strike should be kept to a minimum and must not exceed 5mm.
